Volcanic Legacy Scenic Byway Geology Tour Available

The Volcanic Legacy Community Partnership (VLCP) has prepared an online interpretive geology tour of key volcanic features along the Volcanic Legacy Scenic Byway All-American Road. The tour includes a downloadable map of 26 significant volcanic sites with a brief interpretive description of each site.

The Volcanic Legacy Scenic Byway All-American Road winds 500 miles between Lake Almanor in California and Crater Lake, Oregon. It is one of 32 All-American Roads in the U.S. and showcases the spectacular volcanic landscapes, and natural and cultural resources, that can only be seen in this part of America.

“The byway is a unique volcano-to-volcano drive,” said Allison Scull, VLCP Public Relations Officer. “The array of volcanic features along the route is just amazing! This tour provides you with information on 26 volcanic sites that we hope will encourage visitors and residents alike to explore the byway’s geologic wonders.”
